From 8 to 12 February 2017, classic cars come to Paris for the Retromobile Show

ARTCURIAL MOTORCARS AUCTION

Another highlight of the show is the official auction, to be held on **10 February 2017**. World records for selling prices are often broken at this event, which is organised every year by Artcurial Motorcars. This happened in 2016 with the sale of a Ferrari 335 S Scaglietti from the Bardinon collection, which sold for €32.1 M/\$35.7 M, fees included (historic world record in euros and pounds sterling for a classic car sold at auction) and in 2015 with a 1961 Ferrari 250 GT SWB California Spider from the Baillon collection, which went for €16.3 M/\$18.5 M,
